Key Features

Automatically adds reviews badge on your website

Once you configured all necessary settings in the admin panel, a Google customer reviews badge will appear on your website.

Estimated Delivery Days

With this option, you can estimate an average number of days to deliver an order.

Configuration

- **Enabled** - to enable the extension select "yes";
- **Merchant ID** - type a merchant id. How to get merchant id run to <https://support.google.com/payments/merchant/answer/7163092?hl=en>
- **Estimated Delivery Days** - option allows you to estimate an average number of days to deliver an order.

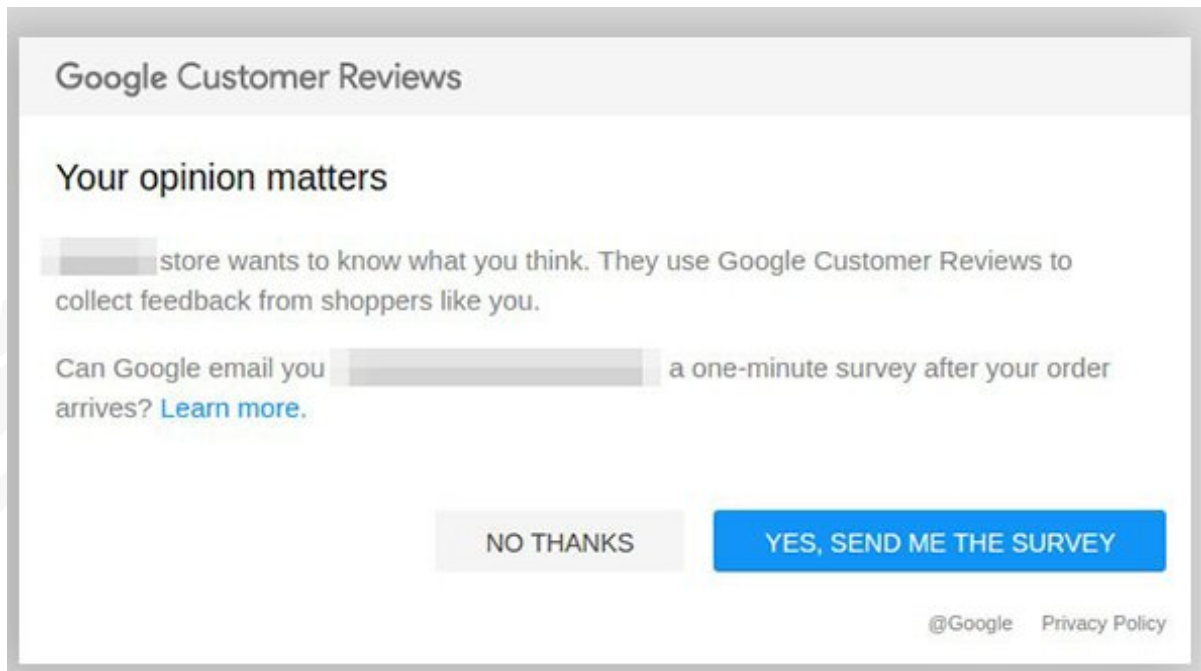

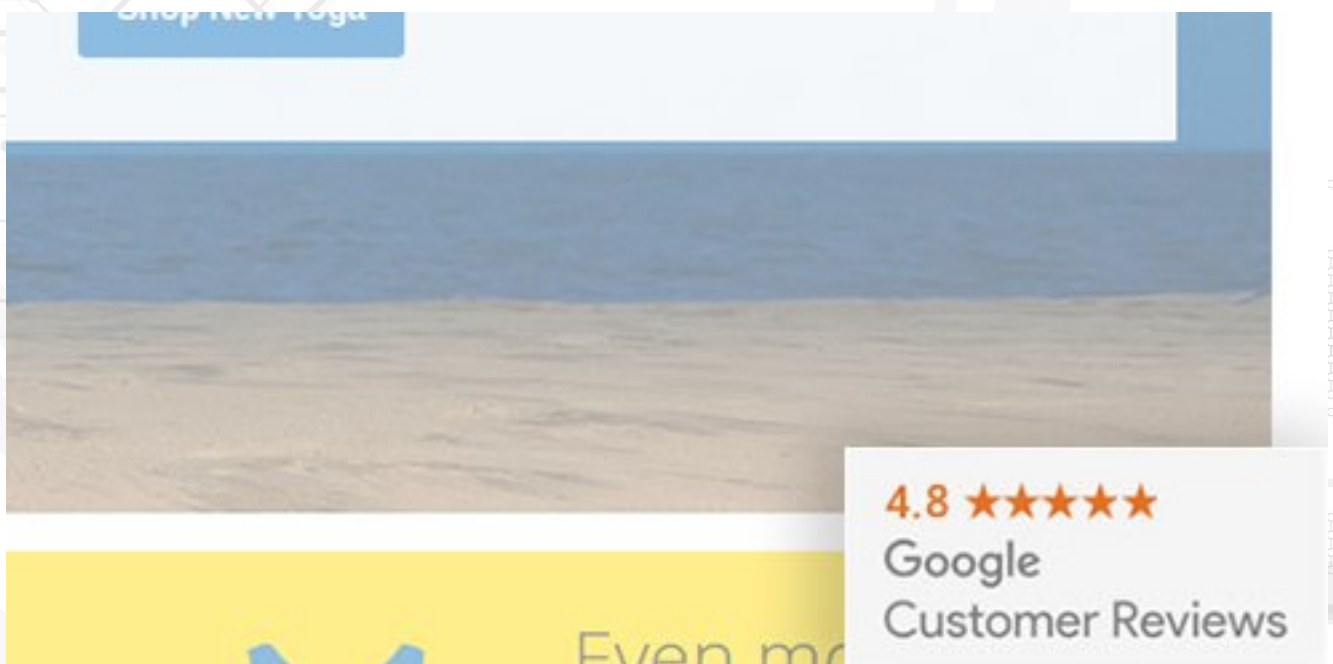
